Portland Fish Exchange Covid19 Protocols Update

Statement:

Portland Fish Exchange is a Covid19 Essential Facility per City of Portland & State of Maine Department of Marine Resources – and will remain in operation, but is limiting operations hours to meet minimum business needs. These protocols will remain in effect, and may be amended as needed.

Building Access:

- Only Portland Fish Exchange & Browne Trading staff along with PFE buyer/seller clients may enter the building
- All other(s) must phone 207 773-0017 on arrival, dial extension 0, state their business for assistance

Portland Fish Exchange & Browne Trading staff:

- All staff must present themselves for screening prior to entering the building
- The designated screener will check forehead temperature(s) and ask of current staff members health along with any other person(s) the staff member may have been in contact with
- All staff will social distance and wear face coverings
- All staff will frequently wash & sanitize hands

Portland Fish Exchange Buyer/Seller Clients:

- If you are ill, or are having flu like symptoms – do not enter the building
- You must sanitize hands prior to entering the building
- You must wear a face covering while in the building
- You will sign in-out in the visitor log
- PFE management reserves the right to screen a client, take a forehead temperature & inquire of their health, if warranted
- Buyer clients will wash & sanitize hands prior to touching computing equipment

Cleaning & Sanitation:

- HACCP Sanitation Procedures remain in effect
- Common Areas will be cleaned & sanitized frequently
- PFE has regular cleaning cycles from an outside vendor
